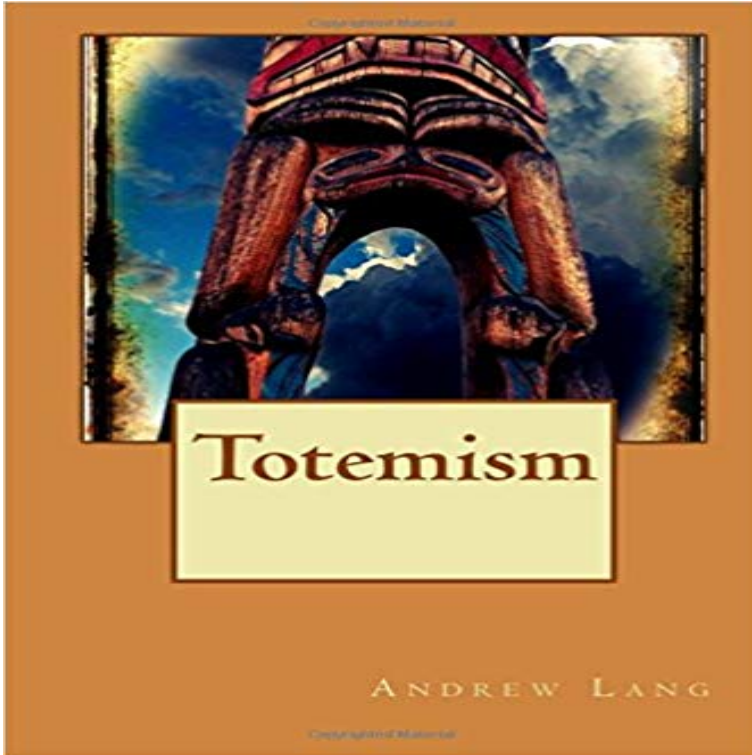


# Totemism
